Sticky Ass Glue

You know that thrill you got as a kid when you'd say a bad word and you didn't get caught? Well, that's how goofy I get when I say the name of this company. Silly yes, but it always makes me smile every time I pick up the bottle. The logo with the bucking, braying donkey is pretty hilarious too!

Stubbornly strong is their motto and it's extremely accurate. This stuff ain't budging. This is great when you want your project to stand the test time; not so great if you're working on something that you'd like to have the option of repositioning something. It just isn't going to happen with this stuff.

I've always been a big fan of home decor projects (just ask my husband about my infamous 6' tall wood screen), but have never really found a glue that fits my needs. I like glue that comes out well, doesn't get the bottle cap all goopy and clogged, doesn't have too strong of an odor, goes on cleanly, doesn't foam out when you camp items together and gives me ample working time before it dries hard. Long list, but this glue sweetly fits the bill.

Instruction as per their website are:

- **Apply A Bit of Water**
Do not soak your surfaces. Lightly mist one surface with a sprayer, or rub with a damp cloth.
- **Stick 'Em Together**
Apply **Sticky Ass Glue** uniformly to dry surface. (Wear gloves or use a brush, please.)
- **Secure 'Em**
Secure the two surfaces together. Fasten together with even pressure. **Sticky Ass Glue** will begin curing immediately, but don't even think about disturbing your project for at least 3 or 4 hours. We advise you to allow 24 hours for surfaces to fully fasten together.

It really is that simple. While I'm not wild about the color of the glue -- it's dark brown in the bottle but dries to a golden brown, great if the glue won't be seen, not so great if you have exposed edges or corners -- but the glue itself is simply amazing.

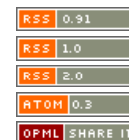
